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Orientation topics for all caregivers, teachers, and directors working in programs receiving Care 4 Kids

1. Prevention and control of infectious diseases (including immunization)
2. SIDS and use of safe sleep practices
3. Administration of medication
4. Prevention/response to food allergies
5. Building and physical premises safety
6. Prevention of shaken baby syndrome and abusive head trauma
7. Emergency preparedness and response planning
8. Storage of hazardous materials and bio-contaminants
9. Precautions in transporting children (if applicable)
10. First-aid and CPR
11. Recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect
12. Child development
13. Nutrition
14. Access to Physical Activity
